# New Landstar U.S./Mexico Logistics Center Opens



Landstar's newly built U.S./Mexico Logistics Service Center in Laredo, Texas officially opened Jan. 19, 2017, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony. Landstar President & CEO Jim Gattoni, other Landstar executives, customers, agents and members of Laredo's Chamber of Commerce were in attendance at the ceremony.

The 31,000 square-foot logistics facility is located on a 50-acre site that accommodates 450 trailers and provides room for future expansion. The center features a highly secure C-TPAT certified site, including a 30-bay cross-dock and transload facility, along with a dedicated platform and heavy/specialized freight area with a

custom 120-ton, stand-alone bridge crane.

Landstar has provided Mexico cross-border services out of Laredo since 1999, and has moved its operations to the new, expanded logistics center.

"We have expanded our cross-border and Mexico freight transportation operations to meet the needs of our customers," said Landstar Transportation Logistics Executive Vice President of Operations Eric Meyer. "Landstar is known for its high level of service and extensive geographic coverage, servicing the Mexico market using more than 1,000 van and platform trailers to accommodate the broad range of commodities that comprise

cross-border trade. The facility will better serve Landstar's customers, capacity providers and agents, and we believe it will position Landstar as the premier freight transport provider of cross-border operations."

Landstar's new logistics center is one of the largest facilities of its kind in Laredo. Its 30-door cross-dock is comprised of more than 20,000 square feet, designed to bring efficiencies to both less-than-truckload (LTL) and transload services. This complements Landstar's LTL business by allowing consolidation of several LTL shipments into one truckload before crossing the border into Mexico.

The new yard is capable of holding more than 450 trailers, which is more than double the capacity of Landstar's previous facility, and has a dedicated heavy-haul section of the yard that includes a custom designed, 120-ton stand-alone bridge crane. The crane has a clearance area of 35 feet high and 37 feet wide to transload many of the largest super loads.

"The 120-ton bridge crane is unique to the cross-border market. It is used to transfer oversize, heavy and specialized loads between various types of platform equipment coming to and from Mexico," said Landstar Transportation Logistics Vice President of Mexico Operations Steve Wisnieski. "Landstar commissioned and directed the design of the new bridge crane to meet our current and future needs, and to allow load transfers to happen safely and efficiently."

The service center also features conference rooms and meeting space for Landstar customers and agents, as well as a state-of-the-art area for Landstar BCOs to conduct business while loading and unloading, including a computer room, media center, lounge, and laundry facility.



### Landstar Scholarship Application Deadline Near

Time to apply for the Landstar Scholarship Fund is running out. Applications for the 2017-2018 school year must be received by March 6, 2017.

Applications for the Landstar Scholarship Fund for the 2017-2018 academic school year are available online at landstar.com/news/scholarship.

The Landstar Scholarship Fund was established to recognize outstanding undergraduate academic achievement and civic involvement of children of Landstar employees, business capacity owners (BCOs) and independent sales agents (agents).

The Landstar Scholarship Fund's recipients are well rounded individuals who succeed both in and out of the classroom, and whose qualities exemplify Landstar's commitment to excellence.

Scholarships are awarded based on a student's:

• Academic excellence

- Extracurricular activities

Eligible candidates must meet the following criteria:

• Scholarships are only available to children of full-time Landstar employees as well as BCOs, agents and employees of BCOs and agents currently under contract with a Landstar company. Children of deceased Landstar employees, BCOs or agents who passed away while employed by or under contract with a Landstar company are also eligible for scholarships.

• To be eligible, candidates must be enrolled in high school and be planning to be enrolled fulltime (12 or more credit hours/semester) at an accredited two- or four-year college or university during the academic year for which the scholarship may be granted.

• All candidates must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

• Candidates enrolled in an accredited two- or four-year college or university must successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours prior to the applications deadline (March 6, 2017).

• Candidates must also be planning to be enrolled full time (12 or more credit hours per semester) at their college or university during the academic year for which the scholarship is granted.

Once the applications are received, an independent selection committee will evaluate all the applications and choose scholarship recipients.

The total number of scholarships awarded in any year cannot exceed 25 percent of the total number of applications received. The number of scholarships to be awarded will be determined following the scholarship application deadline. Award amounts are typically between \$2,500 and \$5,000 per scholarship for the upcoming school year. Awards will be announced during the Landstar Annual Agent Convention in April.

#### More Enhancements To Landstar Connect App Ahead

Testing continues on even more enhancements to the Landstar Connect smartphone application, the mobile freight shipment app that connects Landstar customers, capacity and agents. New releases are in the works now and scheduled for the first quarter of 2017.

Landstar's mobile app provides users the ability to review load details, receive shipment status updates and capture/submit documentation via a smartphone. Customers benefit from the app through reduced time on the phone obtaining shipment status updates by utilizing computer access of critical load details. Capacity providers use the app to upload paperwork to Landstar via TRANSFLO Mobile+ and send required status updates directly from the road with a smartphone.

With auto arrival and departure notification enhancements, capacity providers no longer need to manually update their location and status - the Landstar Connect app automatically updates their arrivals and departures via smart phone for the shipping customer to view.

"The auto arrive and departure feature ensures there is no lag time for agents and their customers who need to know exactly where their freight is and when it's been received," says Eric Meyer, Landstar Transportation Logistics executive vice president of operations. "The extensive GPS load-tracking capabilities of Landstar Connect also delivers to our capacity providers the convenience of not manually needing to check-in."

The app also allows for enhanced cargo security through the activation of a geo-fence around the user's trailer. If the trailer is moved while this geo-fence is active, an alert is sent that a secure geo-fence has been broken. The Store and Forward enhancement improves communications in poor service areas. When the device is in a poor service area, Landstar Connect stores the GPS location and forwards it to the customer when service is regained ensuring there is no loss of tracking data.
